The Korean Intellectual Property Office grants Lleida.net the patent for its registered delivery of electronic mail

Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) n°596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 6/2018 of the Spanish Alternative Investment Market (MAB), we hereby inform you of the following:

The KIPO (Korean Intellectual Property Office) has granted Lleida.net the patent number KR102083313 for its registered receipt of electronic email called “METHOD FOR THE REGISTRATION AND CERTIFICATION OF RECEIPT OF ELECTRONIC MAIL”.

The term of patent is currently in force for 20 years, it is the third Korean patent on registered methods, as well as digital witness for electronic contracting and electronic notification granted to Lleida.net out of a total of 110 patents a worldwide provisional protection.

The Lleida.net method allows automated registration and certification of receipt of email, generating proof of all and can be used as evidence in court to attest receipt, content, delivery and non-tampering of the information and the message.

This new patent will allow the company to expand its business in Korea, in a thriving sector with great potential, such as electronic contracting and notification, and which is booming and necessary in the current circumstances where they are necessary effective online tools. Likewise, this patent is the final granting of the method used by La Liga, published in the relevant event dated February 11, 2020, over which Lleida.net already had provisional protection.
