## Lleida.net grants its first patent in Nigeria for its registered email method with qualified electronic signature.

Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) nº596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 6/2018 of the Spanish Alternative Investment Market (MAB), we hereby inform you of the following:

Lleida.net, a leading company in the field of electronic notification and certification, has received from the Intellectual Property Office in Nigeria the patent for its registered email method with qualified electronic signature, formally known as "Method for the certification of electronic mail containing a recognised signature on the part of a telecommunications operator "with file number NG/PT/C/2018/2994

The term of patent is currently in force for 20 years, it is the first patent on certification methods, as well as a digital witness in electronic contracts and notifications that Lleida.net receives from the Nigerian Intellectual Property Office.

The Lleida.net method allows the sending of digitally signed registered email with a qualified signature without breaking that signature at the time of the certification, as happens in other methods, generating a certificate with legal validity admissible as evidence in the court to prove the sending, the content, delivery and non-tampering of information.
