Lleida.net gets its second patent in Spain registered email method with qualified electronic signature.

Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) n°596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 6/2018 of the Spanish Alternative Investment Market (MAB), we hereby inform you of the following:

Lleida.net, a leading company in the field of electronic notification and certification, has received from the Spanish Patent and Trademark Office (OEPM), the patent for its certified email method with a qualified electronic with number ES2765706 (T3) and whose official name is "**Método para certificar un correo electrónico que comprende una firma digital fiable por un operador de telecomunicaciones**".

The term of patent is currently in force for 20 years, it is the first patent on certification methods, as well as a digital witness in electronic contracts and notifications that Lleida.net receives by the Spanish intellectual property office and derived from the European patent **EP3188435 "Method for certifying an electronic mail comprising a trusted digital signature by a telecommunications operator"**

The Lleida.net method allows the sending of digitally signed registered email with a qualified signature without breaking that signature at the time of the certification, as happens in other methods, generating a certificate with legal validity admissible as evidence in the court to proof the sending, the content, delivery and non-tampering of information.
