**The Israel Patent Office grants Lleida.net a new patent.**

Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) No 596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 15/2016 as well as Circular 3/2020 of BME MFT Equity on information to be provided by Growing Companies, hereby LLEIDANETWORKS SERVEIS TELEMÀTICS, S.A. (hereinafter Lleida.net, or the Company or the Company) brings to your attention the following information that has been prepared under the exclusive responsibility of the issuer and its administrators:

The Israel Patent Office has granted Lleida.net the patent on the issuance of registered electronic mail with a recognized electronic signature called "METHOD FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF ELECTRONIC MAIL CONTAINING A RECOGNISED ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE ON THE PART OF A TELECOMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR" under number 260279. The term of patent is currently in force for 20 years and is the 192-patent granted to Lleida.net worldwide. The complete list can be consulted at <https://www.lleida.net/en/patents>.

This method is used when it is necessary to attest emails signed with a digital signature since the classic methods of email certification break the signature in the attestation process when changes are made to it. It is the fifth patent that Lleida.net has in Israel, having in addition the patent for Registered email, Registered SMS, Registered inbox and the method for generating registered electronic contracts.

All these actions are included within the R&D and industrial property effort that Lleida.net is carrying out worldwide for the purposes of defending the company's intellectual assets, which guarantee barriers against possible unfair competitors.
