Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) No 596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 3/2020 of BME MFT Equity on information to be provided by Growing Companies, we are hereby informing you of the following information relating to LLEIDANETWORKS SERVEIS TELEMÀTICS, S.A.: (hereinafter “Lleida.net”, or the “Company” or the “Enterprise” ) brings to your attention the following information that has been prepared under the exclusive responsibility of the issuer and its administrators:

Within the global effort to digitize the economy and the paperless world, many governments and supranational entities are developing initiatives for the electronic identification of their citizens, such as in Spain the electronic ID or the EIDAS initiative as standardization in the European Union. These efforts initially focus on identifying citizens before official agencies, however, their implementation in the private sector as a universal identification does not usually occur until there is a massive implementation or universal deployment of these forms of electronic identification.

Well, the government of the United Arab Emirates, through its “Paperless” initiatives and its Dubai Smart City Office, its Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (TRA) and the Abu Dhabi Digital Authority promote the UAE Pass initiative as its Digital Identity. Lleida.net, through its Dubai subsidiary and its exclusive partner Emirates Post, has become the first private company authorized to integrate the UAE Pass in the processes of identification, authorization, digital signature, contracting and notification by any entity public and private to use the services of Lleida.net/Emirates Post in the United Arab Emirates.

This implementation allows simplifying the registration process or KYC of any client in processes where a strong identification is needed, such as insurance, energy, communication services companies and as a general matter, in any administrative process.
