**Lleida.net signs a framework agreement with the Pan  
African Postal Union (PAPU) to provide service to the  
55 postal operators on the continent.**

Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) No 596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 3/2020 of BME MTF Equity on information to be provided by Growing Companies, LLEIDANETWORKS SERVEIS TELEMÀTICS, SA: (hereinafter "Lleida.net", or the "Company" or the "Enterprise") brings to your attention the following information that has been prepared under the exclusive responsibility of the issuer and its administrators:

The technology services company Lleida.net (BME:LLN) (EPA:ALLLN) (OTCQX:LLEIF) has signed a framework agreement with the Pan African Postal Union that will allow the 55 national postal operators on the continent to provide digital postal services with Lleida.net's registered communications technology.

Lleida.net has signed the agreement through its subsidiary Lleidanet SaaS Middle East and Africa DMCC and the support of eGate, the company's partner in North Africa.

Founded in 1980, the Pan African Postal Union, under the umbrella of the African Union, was created 40 years ago to coordinate Africa's 55 national postal operators and attract postal innovations to the continent.

Lleida.net's national postal operator clients (we currently have a contract with six of them) generate 70% of the total registered email traffic and all SaaS services. National postal operators now account for 25% of the company's SaaS revenues. This agreement will enable a 10-fold growth in SaaS traffic from postal operators within three years.
