The Japan Patent Office (JPO) has granted the Spanish listed company Lleida.net (BME:LLN; EPA:ALLLN; OTCQX:LLEIF) a new patent entitled 'METHOD FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF ELECTRONIC MAIL CONTAINING A RECOGNISED ELECTRONIC SIGNATURE ON THE PART OF A TELECOMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR' and number 6909233. The term of patent is currently in force for 20 years.

It is the fifth award the Japanese authorities have granted the listed Spanish company.
