## The Dominican Republic authorities have granted Lleida.net a new patent for its Method for Certifying an Electronic Mail comprising a trusted digital signature by a telecommunications operator.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 17 of Regulation (EU) No. 596/2014 on Market Abuse and Article 228 of the consolidated text of the Securities Market Act, passed by Royal Decree 4/2015, of 23 October, and concordant provisions, as well as BME MFT Equity Circular 3/2020 on information to be provided by Empresas en Expansión, LLEIDANETWORKS SERVEIS TELEMÀTICS S.A.: (hereinafter "Lleida.net, or the "Business" or the "Company") hereby brings the following information to your attention which has been drawn up under the sole responsibility of the issuer and its directors:

The National Office of Industrial Property Ministry of Industry, Commerce and SMEs (ONAPI) has granted the Spanish listed company, which has been awarded a new patent in the Dominican Republic, Lleida.net (BME:LLN; EPA:ALLLN; OTCQX:LLEIF) a new patent named 'Method for the certification of electronic mail containing an electronic signature on behalf of a telecommunications operator' with numberP2018-0155. The concession period is 20 years.

This is the second patent that the listed Spanish company has been awarded by the authorities of the Dominican Republic.

Lleida.net's growth strategy in the electronic signature, notification and procurement market in the countries it already operates in and which it plans to enter into in the future, includes a solid growth policy in intellectual property and R&D, as well as strengthening its internationalisation policy.

This brings the number of patents granted to Lleida.net worldwide for online certification, notification and procurement methods to 207; an average of one patent granted every eleven days since the company was listed on the stock market.
