## India grants Lleida.net patent for its Registered SMS method

Under the provisions of Article 17 of the Regulation (EU) No 596/2014 regarding market abuse and article 228 of the modified text of the Spanish Stock Market Act, approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October and related provisions, as well as Circular 3/2020 of BME MFT Equity on information to be provided by Growing Companies, we are hereby informing you of the following information relating to LLEIDANETWORKS SERVEIS TELEMÀTICS, S.A.: (hereinafter "Lleida.net", or the "Company "or the "Enterprise") brings to your attention the following information that has been prepared under the exclusive responsibility of the issuer and its administrators:

The Indian Patent Office (Intellectual Property India) has granted Spanish listed company Lleida.net (BME:LLN; EPA:ALLLN; OTCQX:LLEIF) a patent for its text message certification method called 'METHOD FOR CERTIFYING DELIVERY OF SMS/MMS DATA MESSAGES TO MOBILE TERMINALS' and number 391632. The patent has been granted for a period of 20 years.

It is the first time India's intellectual property authorities have granted the Spanish listed company this recognition in a market with 1.8 billion mobile connections, 700 million Internet users and 600 million smartphones.

The strategy of Lleida.net's growth in the electronic signature, notification and contracting market, where the company is already established and planning to be in the future, relies on a solid growth policy in intellectual property and R&D and on strengthening its globalisation policy.

This makes 210 patents granted to Lleida.net worldwide on certification, notification and online contracting methods ever since the company was first listed on Stock Exchange.
